The following data protection information provides an overview of the collection, processing and use of personal data provided as part of the AqQua project.

<u>Collection of personal data and purpose:</u> As part of the AqQua project, we process the personal data provided by you in the above form for the purpose of naming you as co-author of the resulting publication of the AqQua dataset as part of the Data Provider Consortium. The same applies if you actively participate as a co-author in a resulting foundation model publication or in publications on derived global distribution patterns and process rates. A further purpose is the publication of any acknowledgements provided by you.

<u>Legal basis:</u> We process your personal data for the implementation of pre-contractual measures and for the subsequent fulfillment of the contract (Art. 6 para. 1, p. 1 lit. b GDPR). Inclusion in the mailing list only takes place with your consent (Art. 6 para. 1, sentence 1 lit. a GDPR).

<u>Disclosure to third parties:</u> Disclosure to third parties only takes place through the publication of your personal data as described above.

<u>Transfer to third countries:</u> There is no active transfer of your personal data to countries outside the European Economic Area.

<u>Storage period</u>: The criteria for determining the duration of storage of your personal data are based on the end of the purpose and the subsequent statutory retention period. Your data will be deleted from our internal systems as soon as the research project has been completed and there are no further retention periods. The publication of your personal data as part of your co-authorship will remain permanently.

Rights of the data subjects: Every data subject has the right of access under Art. 15 GDPR, the right to rectification under Art. 16 GDPR, the right to erasure under Art. 17 GDPR, the right to restriction of processing under Art. 18 GDPR, the right to object under Art. 21 GDPR and the right to data portability under Art. 20 GDPR within the scope of the statutory provisions. The restrictions under Sections 34 and 35 BDSG apply to the right to information and the right to erasure. In addition, there is a right of appeal to a competent data protection supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR in conjunction with Section 19 BDSG). You can revoke your consent to the processing of personal data at any time with effect for the future.
